

Promoting gender equality in pensions is a project that aims to generate discussion about differences between pensions paid to men and women. Another aim is to improve people's and decision-makers' awareness of the reasons behind the pension gap. The project will compile and distribute information to decision-makers and strive to bring the gender perspective into public discussion and decision-making.

This project also aims to make people more aware of how family leave and career breaks due to family leave affect pension size. In addition, those approaching retirement age are invited to consider their options from the perspective of their future pension.

The project is coordinated by the Ministry of Social Affairs and Health and is carried out in cooperation with the Finnish Centre for Pensions, the Social Insurance Institution of Finland (Kela) and the Finnish Pension Alliance (Tela).
